

Previous Renewals / Surveys, etc.

Corner originally set by James Currin and James Noland under special instructions dated May 4th 1889. Their record reads: A pine, 16 ins. in diam. marked 1/4 S. on N. face for 1/4 sec. cor; from which a pine 12 ins. in diam. bears N20° W 60 lks. dist. marked 1/4S.B.T.; a pine 10 ins. in diam. bears S55°W 25 lks. dist. marked 1/4 S.B.T.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)

The decayed "solid pitch" pine core of the S.W. BT stump with the bottom of the blazed face and a partial scribe. Also, the remains of the "solid pitch" core of the 1/4 corner tree about 8 feet long lying on its side with no visible remains of the corner markings.

MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)
In the stump hole of the 1/4 corner pine snag I set a 1"x24" iron rebar with a 2" aluminum cap stamped as shown in the diagram above.

For references, I set four 5/8" by 24" rebars with 1 1/8" orange plastic caps stamped WTS and 56295LS as described below:

an iron rebar bears S04°49'54"E, 72.41 feet;

an iron rebar bears N22°25'47"E, 122.85 feet;

an iron rebar bears N50°15'28"W, 77.30 feet;

an iron rebar bears S34°26'24"W, 108.12 feet;

The monument and references were tied using a Trimble R7/R8 RTK GPS system.
