

At position by Survey I set a $5/8" \times 30"$ iron pin, 29" in the ground, with 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below, from which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 12" Ponderosa Pine bears South 15° East, a dist. of 47.65 ft., marked NE 1/16 S23 BT. An 11" Ponderosa Pine bears North 61° West, a dist. of 19.90 ft., marked NE 1/16 S23 BT.

Set steel fence post approx. 0.5 ft. West

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the new accessories. I used 14° East declination. Distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the bearing trees. Bearings are to a brass washer marked OPLS 83571 in the BT blaze of the new bearing tree
