

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO MONUMENT THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At position by Survey I set a $5/8" \times 22"$ iron pin, drilled 18" into rock, with 2 ½" aluminum cap marked as shown below, in a 2' diam. collar of stone, from which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 9" Ponderosa Pine bears North 37° East a dist. of 37.65 ft., marked NE 1/16 S19 BT. A double bole Ponderosa Pine, both boles being 8" diam., bears South 8° East a dist. of 76.35 ft., marked NE 1/16 S19 BT on most easterly bole.

Set steel fence post approx. 0.3 ft. North

Falls approx. 20 ft. North of Northeasterly running forest road.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the new accessories. I used 13° East declination, the distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the bearing trees. A brass washer marked OPLS 83571 is attached to the BT blaze of the new bearing trees.
