

At position by Survey I set a  $5/8" \times 30"$  iron pin, 27" in the ground, with 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below, in mound of stone 1' diam., from which:

## NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 5/8"  $\times$  30" iron pin bears North 65° East, a dist. of 38.42 ft., with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked BGB Survey marker NE RP. A  $5/8" \times 30"$  iron pin bears South 77°39' West, a dist. of 30.36 ft., with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked BGB Survey marker SW RP.


