

At position by Survey I set a $5/8" \times 30"$ iron pin, 28" in the ground, with 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below, in a mound of stone 2' diam., from which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 12" White Fir bears North 29° East, a dist. of 13.15 ft., marked LOT 6 CC UIR BT. A 10" Douglas Fir bears South, a dist. of 53.30 ft., marked LOT 7 CC UIR BT.

Set steel fence post approx. 1 ft. East


