

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At position established by survey, I set a 5/8" x 30" iron rebar with a 2 ½" aluminum cap marked as shown below, 28 inches in the ground, in a collar of stone 1 ½ ft. diam., from which:

- A 13 inch Ponderoas Pine bears South 66° East, a distance of 44.20 feet, marked CW 1/16 S19 BT.
- A 7 inch Ponderosa Pine bears North 44° West, a distance of 40.65 feet, marked X BT.
- I set a steel fencepost approximately 1 ft. North of corner monument.
- I hereby certify that the corner was monumented on September 9, 2013.
