

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO MONUMENT THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At position determined by survey, I set a 5/8"x24" iron pin, 18" in the ground with a 2 ½" aluminum cap, marked as shown below, in a collar of stone 3 ft. diam., from which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 5/8" x 15" iron pin bears South 29°03' East, a dist. of 9.85 ft., with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked SE RP.

A $5/8" \times 15"$ iron pin bears South 64°51' West, a dist. of 9.01 ft., with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked SW RP.

Set steel fence post approx. 1 ft. North


