

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At position established by survey, I set a $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap marked as shown below, 24 inches in the ground, in a mound of stone $1 \frac{1}{2}$ ft. diam., from which:

A 7 inch Ponderosa Pine bears North 81° East, a distance of 36.00 feet, marked C 1/4 S19 BT. A 12 in. Ponderosa Pine bears South 40° East, a distance of 11.70 feet, marked C 1/4 S19 BT. A 9 inch Ponderosa Pine bears South 82° West, a distance of 25.60 feet, marked C 1/4 S19 BT. A 12 inch Ponderosa Pine bears North 7° West, a distance of 15.45 feet, marked C 1/4 S19 BT.

I set a steel fencepost approximately 1 ft. North of corner monument. An East/West fenceline falls approximately 1 ft. South of the monument.

I hereby certify that the corner was monumented on September 9, 2013.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the bearing trees. Magnetic declination used was 16° East. Bearings are to a washer marked OPLS 83571 in the lower BT blaze. Distances are to a 60d spike in the right hand side of the root crown of the bearing trees.
