

A 5" Ponderosa Pine bears North 20° East, a dist. of 11.25 ft., marked S 1/16 S24 BT. A 7" Douglas Fir bears South 80° West, a dist. of 44.80 ft., marked S 1/16 S23 BT.

Set steel fence post approx. 1 ft. South



Distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the bearing trees. Bearings are to a brass washer marked OPLS 83571 is attached to the BT blaze of the new bearing trees.
