

An 8 inch White Fir bears North 72° East, a distance of 10.00 feet, marked W 1/16 S22 BT. An 8 inch Lodgepole Pine bears South 26° East, a distance of 15.55 feet, marked W 1/16 S27


I set a steel fencepost approx. 1 foot East of corner monument. I hereby certify that the corner was monumented on November 8, 2012.
