

At position by Survey I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin, 28" in the ground, with 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below, with a collar of stone 2' in diam., from which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

An 8" Ponderosa Pine bears South, a dist. of 34.50 ft., marked E 1/16 S26 BT. A 9" Douglas Fir bears North 35° West, a dist. of 9.90 ft., marked E 1/16 S23 BT.

Set steel fence post approx. 1 ft. East

Distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the bearing trees. Bearings are to a brass washer marked OPLS 83571 is attached to the BT blaze of the new bearing trees.
