

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO MONUMENT THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At position determined by survey, I set a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe, 27" in the ground, with 3" aluminum cap, marked as shown below, from which:

NEW BEARING OBJECT:

A 14" Douglas Fir bears North 13° East, a distance of 16.40 feet, marked C 1/4 S30 BT.


A 6" Ponderosa Pine bears South 49° East, a distance of

24.70 feet, marked C 1/4 S30 BT. An 8" Ponderosa Pine bears South 44° West, a distance of 11.90 feet, marked C 1/4 S30 BT.

A 4" White Fir bears North 53° West, a distance of 19.65

feet, marked X BT.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the new accessories. I used 14° East declination, the distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the bearing trees. A brass washer marked OPLS 83571 is attached to the BT blaze of the new bearing trees.
