

At position determined by survey I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin, 28" in the ground, with 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap marked as shown below, from which:

#### NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 6" White Fir bears South 42° East a dist. of 4.45 ft., marked N 1/16 S33 BT. A 5" Lodgepole Pine bears South 28° West a dist. of 7.95 ft., marked N 1/16 S32 BT.



I used 13° East declination, the distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the bearing trees. A brass washer marked OPLS 83571 is attached to the BT blaze of the new bearing trees.
