A 9" Western Larch bear S55°W-9.1 feet scribed ½ S32BT.
A 10" Ponderosa Pine bears S51°E-55.7 feet scribed ½ S33BT.

Used staff compass with  $20\,^{\circ}$  East declination and measured to the center of the bearing trees.
