CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner established in 1882 by Herman D. Gradon, US Deputy Surveyor, under Contract Number 452. The Surveyor General's records state:

Set a basalt stone 14x9x7 ins. 9 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor. marked 1/4 on W-face and raised a mound of stone alongside.

The 1/4 section was monumented in 1998, by Kaiser/Griffin/ Seibold, Cadastral Surveyors under Bureau of Land Management Group No. 1844. The field notes state:

Point for the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 5, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2-1/2 ins. diam., 16 ins. in the ground, to solid rock, and supported in a mound a stone, 3 ft. base, to top, with brass cap, from which:

A ponderosa pine, 46 ins. diam., bears S.1-1/4° W., 620 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S5 BT.

Deposited a magnet in a white plastic case at the base of the stainless steel post.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found 3-1/4" brass cap marked per the diagram on a 2-1/2" pipe, 0.6 feet above the ground in large rock mound.

Burnt and dead Ponderosa Pine bears S.01°W., 409.2 feet. (BLM Bearing Tree).

<u>Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:</u>

Chiseled "X" on South face 3 foot up from base of a 3' \times 2' \times 5.5' rock outcrop, bears N.37°W., 65.9 feet. Chiseled "X" on Northwest face 1 foot up from base of a 1' \times 1' \times 1.5' rock, bearing S.67°E. 36.2 feet. Set 5/8" \times 24" rebar with 1-1/2" aluminum cap, bears N.54°E., 21.1 feet, stamped WSI/RM 21.1, 2535. Set 5/8" \times 24" rebar with 1-1/2" aluminum cap, bears N.72°W., 19.7 feet, stamped WSI/RM 19.7, 2535.

Reference monuments have an arrow pointing towards the corner. Appropriate signs have been attached to all bearing trees as required by this US Forest Service contract. 20° declination was used. Fieldwork was performed in May 2002.
