## History of original corner establishment:

The original corner was established by George S. Pershin, deputy, (compassman) on November 2, 1871, under joint GLO contract No. 154, as follows:

1/4 S32|S33 PLS 1636 2003

Set a stone, 18" x 6" x 5", for 1/4 section corner. Va: 19° 08' E

## Original corner evidence recovered:

Found the original corner stone solidly set and protruding 8" out of the ground. The corner stone is on the west edge of a mound of three stones. The corner stone is 20" x 9" x 6" and is plainly marked "1/4" on the west face.

## Monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original position of this corner:

In place of the original corner stone, I set a  $1" \times 30"$  flared, galvanized iron pipe 24" into the ground. A 2 1/2" brass cap attached to the top of the pipe is marked as shown in the diagram above. I bury the corner stone along the south side of the pipe and place the original mound around the pipe, from which:

A 5/8" x 24" iron rod set 23" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 NE", attached at ground level, bears N37° 30' E, 77.2 feet.

A 5/8" x 36" iron rod set 34" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 SE", attached at ground level, bears S27° E, 115.0 feet.

A 5/8" x 36" iron rod set 35" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 SW", attached at ground level, bears \$28° 30' W, 119.1 feet.

A 5/8" x 24" iron rod set 21" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 NW", attached at ground level, bears N42° W, 112.9 feet.

I hereby certify the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on March 10, 2003. Magnetic declination set in compass: 21° E.
