The monument is cemented into a hole chiseled into rock. A sealed well casing bears N22°16'W, 6.40 feet marked with a punch mark, an arrow and the letters BO. I set three 5/8" by 24" rebars with 1.25" red plastic caps stamped ORLS 852 and WALS 13922 as described below: a rebar bears N2°48'E, 38.61 feet under an east - west fence; a rebar bears S74°42'W, 90.88 feet at the base of a power pole; a rebar bears S76°42'E, 112.11 feet; at the base of a power pole The bearings are true.
