

Corner originally set by Daniel Chaplin under contract No. 107 Dated September 21, 1864. His record reads: Set stone 18"x10"x6" for 1/4 section corner.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source) None.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)

Set a 1 1/4" x 30" Galvanized Iron Pipe with a 2 1/2" brass cap stamped a shown in the diagram above at the intersection of the line between the NE and SE section corners of section with the line from the West quarter corner of section 9 projected through the center quarter as identified from the plat of the Royer Addition to the City of Pilot Rock. The position falls one foot west of a North - South fence line.

For references, I set four 5/8" by 24" rebars with 1.25" red plastic caps stamped ORLS 852 and WALS 13922 as described below:

an iron rebar bears N1°12'05"E, 96.83 feet in the existing fence;

an iron rebar bears N1°58'00"E, 46.63 feet in the existing fence;

an iron rebar bears S0°54'22"E, 49.91 feet in the existing fence;

an iron rebar bears S0°28'40"E, 103.25 feet in the existing fence;

This monument and references were set and tied used a LIECA system 300 RTK GPS
