Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

The corner was set at the intersection of the line of a fence which runs to the North with the centerline of County Road No. 1150. This location Was indicated in the County Road Survey and was found acceptable. I set a 1 1/2"x24" Galvanized Iron Pipe with a 2 1/2" Brass Cap in a 8"x24" concrete cylinder, 1" below the surface of the asphalt in the center of the right of way of County Road 1150, stamped as in the diagram above. A 5/8"x24" rebar with 2" Al cap bears S89°59'E, 30.0', stamped B.O., ORLS 852, AND WALS 13922.

A 5/8"X24" rebar with 2" Al cap bears N1°01'E, 28.9', stamped B.O., ORLS 852, AND WALS 13922.

A 5/8"X24" rebar with 2" Al cap bears N89°16'W, 30.1', stamped B.O., ORLS 852, AND WALS 13922.

A 5/8"X24" rebar with 2" Al cap bears S02°21'E, 29.0', stamped B.O., ORLS 852, AND WALS 13922.

The bearings are based on the fence line to the north being north.
