

Previous Renewals / Surveys, etc.

Corner originally set by Daniel Chaplin under contract No. 107 dated Sept 21,1864. His record reads: Set post for 1/4 Sec. Cor., in mound of earth, with charred stake, pits, etc., as per instructions.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)

I found a concrete ball with a 3/4in iron pipe running horizontally through it. Long time Pilot Rock resident Bill Etter SR. told me that he had witnessed this monument being disturbed during flood cleanup of the schoolyard. The pipe bears N34°30'46"W, 3.31ft.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)

I set a 1 1/2" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with a 2 1/4" brass cap stamped as shown in the diagram above. The monument was set at the correct position based on ties to the monuments of the Mcdevitts Addition, plat book 7, page 33.

For references, I set four 5/8" by 24" green coated iron rebars with 1 1/8" orange plastic caps stamped WTS and 56295LS as described below:

- a rebar bears N41°58'24"W, 30.92 feet;
- a rebar bears N44°09'25"E, 31.63 feet;
- a rebar bears S54°51'34"E, 32.61 feet;
- a rebar bears S54°30'45"W, 73.84 feet;

The monument and references were tied using a LIECA system 300 RTK GPS.
