


Previous Renewals / Surveys, etc.

Corner originally set by Daniel Chaplin under contract No. 107 dated September 21, 1864. His record reads: Set post for 1/4 sec cor in mound of earth with charred stake, pits &c as per instructions.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)

I found the rotten remains of the original stake approximately 2 feet south of a long term fence corner with fences running south and east. The stake was 3" x 3", squared and charred on all sides.





MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)

I set a 2 1/2"brass cap on a 1 1/4" x 30" galvanized iron pipe flush with the surface. The cap was stamped as shown in the diagram above. I buried the remains of the original post in a white plastic cup on the north side of the monument.

For references I set four 5/8" x 24" iron rebars with 1 1/8" orange plastic caps stamped WTS and 56295LS as described below:

an iron rebar bears N84°16'10"E, 19.11 feet on the south side of the existing fence; an iron rebar bears N87°55'40"E, 37.73 feet on the south side of the existing fence; an iron rebar bears S2°46'18"W, 20.89 feet on the east side of the existing fence; an iron rebar bears S1°33'04"S, 44.35 feet on the east side of the existing fence;

The references were tied using a Trimble R7/R8 RTK GPS
