

Corner originally set by David P. Thompson under contract No. 106 Dated August 16, 1864. His record reads: Set stone, 28 x 10 x 6 ins. for corner to sections 4, 5, 32, and 33.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)

A fence intersection with fences running East, West, and North. The intersection is visually in line with the centerline of a road known to be on the section line two miles to the north. There is a large rock jack at the corner.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description) Set a 1"x30" rebar at the point of intersection of the fences for the corner monument.

For references, I set four 5/8" by 24" rebars with 1.25" red plastic caps stamped ORLS 852 and WALS 13922 as described below:

a rebar bears N4°53'W, 84.81 feet under the existing fence;

a rebar bears N89°39'W, 42.29 feet under the existing fence;

a rebar bears N89°39'E, 61.75 feet under the existing fence;

a rebar bears N89°17'E, 97.52 feet under the existing fence:

Monument and reference locations were surveyed with GPS recievers in stop and go mode.

The bearings are true. The distances are grid.
