

Corner originally established by Currin and Nolan in 1889 under special contract dated May 4, 1889. They set a 16x10x8 ins. stone 10 ins. in ground for cor. to secs. 8, 9, 16 & 17, marked 4 notches on S. & 4 notches on E. edges and raised a mound of stone around it. Their notes called for a draw bottom 0.75 chains east and a ridge top trail 10.5 chains north.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)

Found a mound of stones with an unmarked record size stone at the record call distances from the draw bottom and the trail.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description) Set a 1.5 " x 30" galvanized iron pipe with 2 1/2" brass cap 29" in the ground stamped as shown in the diagram above. Buried corner stone alongside.
