## MONUMENT SET:

Set a 1" diameter by 30" long galvanized iron pipe with a 2 1/2" brass cap, projecting 6" out of the ground in surrounding rock mound, marked as shown in monument marking detail.

Monument has a 6' steel fence post alongside with witness sign attached.

A 9" diameter lodgepole pine bears N 67° E, 21.0 feet, scribed "1/4 S3 BT" on double blaze.

A 12" diameter lodgepole pine bears S 61° E, 48.6 feet, scribed "1/4 S10 BT" on double blaze.

A 9" diameter lodgepole pine bears S 06° W, 82.8 feet, scribed "1/4 S10 BT" on double blaze.

A 9" diameter lodgepole pine bears N 72° W, 49.5 feet, scribed "1/4 S3 BT" on double blaze.

Each new bearing tree has a Umatilla County bearing tree sign attached above the upper blaze and a brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed to the face of the lower blaze, with face of blazes painted red.
