

Description of Corner as Set:

This monument was perpetuated by Lawrence D. Holmes, BLM Cadastral Surveyor under special instructions dated September 22, 1983, Group No. 1184, Oregon. The monument was reestablished at record bearing and distance from the original bearing tree. The field notes state:

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diameter, with magnetic, plastic breakaway, 6 ins. in the ground, to solid rock, supported in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, to top, with a brass cap marked:

from which a new bearing tree

A ponderosa pine, 9 ins. diameter, bears N. 35° W., 160 LKS distance marked ¼ S 24 BT.


Description of Corner Evidence Found:

Found 3" brass cap set in 4' diameter. collar of stone with fence post set in 3' mound of stone to north in good condition.

From which:

A 24" ponderosa pine bears S45°W, 50' distance, with healed over blaze.

An 11" ponderosa pine bears N35°W, 160 LKS, with partially healed blaze.
