## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

## History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by Herman D. Gradon under GLO contract number 452, dated June 16, 1882. Surveyor General record states:
Set a basalt stone 12x9x5 ins 8 ins in the ground for ½ sec cor
marked ½ on W face, from which;
pine 20 ins diam bears N50°W 112 lks dist marked ½S BT
No other tree within limits and raised a mound of stone alongside
Corner remonumented in 1972 by Douglas M. Ferguson, OPLS 848. His
record states:
Found 26 in pine live in good condition with scribing visible.
Established corner position S50°E 74 ft distance from BT.
Set 30 in x 2½ in iron pipe with 3 in brass cap marked as shown
26 in in the ground and raised a mound of stone around the pipe for the ½ corner between
Sec 1 and 2 from which a new BT- A fir 16 in diam bears S12°E 11.4 ft dist marked T1S R36E
S1 BT. Distance taken to a brass washer in the blase of the BT. Set a steel fencepost
approximately 5 ft. North from corner. states:

DIAGRAM T1S R36E C-21

No record of subsequent monumentation found in Umatilla County survey records.

## Description of corner evidence found:


Found a 3" brass cap monument marked as shown:

ORIGINAL BEARING TREE Found a 28 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine N50°W, 112 lks, live but sickly with scribes visible.

FERGUSON BEARING TREE Found a 21 inch diameter Douglas Fir S12°E, 11.4 feet, live and vigorous with blaze evident.

Distances to the BTs are to the estimated face of blaze.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner: From the above described corner monument:

New Bearing Tree: A 12 inch diameter Douglas Fir bears N83°W, 10.05 feet marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S2 BT

Painted a 6 inch red band around all BTs and attached bearing tree and land survey monument signs.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet North with Property Boundary and Land Survey Monument signs attached.
