Found 12 in. spruce, live in good condition, with scribing visible, bearing $\rm S11^{OE}$ 11.2 ft. dist. from the original post.

Accepted post as corner position.

Set 30 in. \times $2\frac{1}{2}$ in. Iron pipe with 3 in. brass cap marked as shown, 26 in. in the ground for the East 1/4 Corner to Section 1.

No new bearing trees taken.
