
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Description of corner evidence found:

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At position determined by survey, I set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 40 inches in the ground, from which:

New Bearing Trees: A 11 inch diameter Douglas Fir bears N31°E, 54.04 feet marked SW 1/16 S1 BT A 28 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears N79°E, 30.80 feet marked SW 1/16 S1 BT

Painted a 6 inch red band around all BTs and attached bearing tree and land survey monument signs.

Set a steel fence post approximately 10.3 feet South with Land Survey Monument and Property Boundary signs attached.

Corner falls in Westerly wheel track of a private road.

I hereby certify that the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on September 10, 1989.
