
History of original corner establishment:

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At position determined by survey, I set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 30 inches in the ground, from which:

New Bearing Trees: A 12 inch diameter Western Larch bears S28°W, 17.70 feet marked W 1/16 S12 BT A 8 inch diameter Western Larch bears N36°W, 24.12 feet marked W 1/16 S1 BT

Painted a 6 inch red band around all BTs and attached bearing tree and land survey monument signs.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet North with land survey monument and property boundary signs attached.

I hereby certify that the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on August 18, 1989.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of new accessories. I used 17° East magnetic declination and the distances are to a 50d spike driven in the right side of the root crown. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 644 to the BT blaze.
