A 16" ponderosa pine bears N  $36\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$  W - 78.8 feet, with healed blaze. A 33" ponderosa pine bears S 29  $3/4^{\circ}$  W - 37.2 feet, with scribing visible.

A 18" ponderosa pine bears S 76° E - 48.8 feet, with healed blaze.

New accessories established:

A steel fence post set 3.8 feet West of monument with 54-2 and 54-9 signs
