Accepted stone as corner position.

Set 30 in. x  $2\frac{1}{2}$  in. iron pipe with 3 in. brass cap marked as shown, 26 in. in the ground and placed original stone North and alongside pipe for the

1/4 corner between Sections 7 & 18, from which new BT's
A fir 9 in. diam. bears ME7°E 8.6 ft. dist. marked TIS R36E 1/4 S7

A ponderosa pine 12 in. diam. bears \$48°W 28.6 ft. dist. marked TIS R56E 1/4 S 18 BT.

Distances taken to a brass washer in the blaze of each tree. Set a steel fence post approximately 5 ft. North from corner with Forest Coundary sign attached.

Used steel tape and magnetic compass with declaration = 20° East.
