

Mistory of original corner establishment: Corner established in 1882 by Herman D. Gradon, under General Land Office Contract #452. Surveyor General records (notes) states:

Set a basalt stone 16 x 14 x 6 ins. II ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor. marked 1/4 on W face, from which a pine 36 ins. diam. bears N 50° W 100 lks. dist. marked 1/4 S B.T. No other tree within limits & raised a mound of stone alongside.



(No subsequent remonumentations in county records)

Description of corner evidence found:

Found 45 in. penderosa pine, live in good condition, with scribing visible. Established corner position \$ 50° E 66 ft. dist. from Bearing Tree, found an old mound of stone alongside.

Description of manument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

Set a 30 in. \times $2\frac{1}{2}$ in. iron pipe with brass cap marked as shown, 15 ins. in the ground to solid rock, with "X" chiseled in rock under pipe, for the 1/4 corner between Sec. 19 and 20, and raised a 5 ft. \times 2 ft. mound of stone around the pipe, from which a 14 in. fir bears N 63° E 55 ft. dist. marked T15, R3GE 1/4 S 20 BT. Distance taken to a brass washer in the face

Set a steel fence post approximately 6 ft. north of pipe with "Attention" sign attached.

Used steel tape and magnetic compass with declaration = 20° East.
