Description of manument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

Set a 2½ -inch brass cap on a 2-inch iron pipe, 31 inches long, 6 inches above ground in an earth and rock mound with 6 ft. steel fence post alongside and sign 54-4 attached. Monument marked:

T 1 S R 36 E

S 29 S 32 RPE 2808 1976

A 10" fir bears N. 15° 30' E., 41.8 ft. dist., mkd. ¼ S 29 BT.

A 12" larch bears S. 69° 30' E., 39.0 ft. dist., mkd. 14 S 32 BT.

Placed signs 51-2 on north and east edges of a 8" fir alongside corner monument.
