
. TIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Original monument was a 3½ foot post with bearing ties. Arnold Gibson visited this sight in 1969 and found no evidence of post or bearing trees. To perpetuate the monument he set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "Oregon State Board of Forestry ¼ S31 1969 RS 359", 18 inches in ground, in line with original blazes, in mound of rock at 40 chains north on east boundary of Section 36.

As assessories: A 10" fir bears S10°E, 41.7 ft. to face, marked ¼ S31 Bt. A 14" fir bears S14°W, 34.3 ft. to face, marked ¼ S31 Bt.

A 4" x 4" x 48" white cedar post 2.0 ft. SW of corner.



Description of corner evidence found:

Found 3" bronze cap on 1½" galvanized iron pipe with 18" protruding above ground marked Oregon State Board of Forestry ¼ S31 1969 RS 359.

A 4" x 4" white cedar post stands SW 7 ft.±, no evidence of bearing trees.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

New assessories set:

A brass cap, (2") diameter, on a (11/4") diameter galvanized iron pipe (30") long bears N 83° W 57.50', with steel post/paddle alongside.

A brass cap (2") diameter, on a (11/4") diameter galvanized iron pipe (30") long bears S 22° W, 54.02', with steel post/w paddle alongside.

A 5/8" iron rod with aluminum cap stamped OSHD bears N 22° E, 168.60 ft. with steel post alongside.

A5/8" iron rod with OSHD aluminum cap bears S 83° E 196.49' with steel post alongside.

Distances measured with DI 1600, bearings established with Silva compass at 20° dec.
