## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

## History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by Jacob C. Cooper under GLO contract number 397, dated July 1, 1881. Surveyor General record states:

Set post  $3\frac{1}{4}$  ft long 3 ins square 18 ins in the ground on the S hillside 150 ft above bottom of ravine in open timber for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. marked  $\frac{1}{4}$ S on E and W faces from which;

A pine 18 ins diam bears S89°W 10 lks dist marked ¼S BT No other trees in limits and raised a mound of stone alongside.

Range line resurveyed by Henry Meldrum under GLO contract number 450, dated June 11, 1882. Surveyor General record states:
As the corners on the West boundary of this Township are not suitable for survey of T1S R37E. . I am therefore compelled to resurvey it. 48.57 ch-The ½ sec corner. (Meldrum did not destroy any marks or accessories as there were none referring to R37E)

No record of subsequent monumentation found in Umatilla County survey records.

## Description of corner evidence found:

Found no evidence of the original corner monument.

Found a 24 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine S89°W, 10 lks, live and vigorous with blaze evident.

Distance to the original bearing tree is to the estimated face of blaze.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At record bearing and distance from the above described original bearing tree, I set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 27 inches in the ground, from which:

New Bearing Tree: A 9 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears N16°W, 22.57 feet marked ¼ S36 BT

Raised a small mound of stone around monument.

Painted a 6 inch red band around all BTs and attached bearing tree and land survey monument signs.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet South with land survey monument sign attached.

I hereby certify that the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on September 20, 1989.
