No record of subsequent monumentation found in Umatilla County survey records.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found a 10 ft. chunk of 14-16 inch diameter Western Larch with blaze and chop marks with very faint scribes visible. Impossible to determine the exact origin of the tree, as the area has been violently torn up by logging.

I place this corner at the intersection of the base line between Townships 1 North and 1 South, and the projected East line of Section 1. This position is harmonious with the area of the found bearing tree, the spring branch call to the East, and also with the existing blaze line to the South. There is an excess along the base line of approximately 3 chains, which would make a true proportionate position for this corner in conflict with the existing conditions.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At the above described corner position, I set a 2½" x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 30 inches in the ground, from which:

New Bearing Trees: A 25 inch diameter Western Larch bears S55°E, 187.45 feet marked T1S R37E S6 CC BT A 22 inch diameter Hemlock bears S15°E, 54.10 feet marked T1S R37E S6 CC BT No trees available in the Southwest quadrant. Distance to the Western Larch BT taken electronically due to length and slope.

Painted a 6 inch red band around all BTs and attached bearing tree and land survey monument signs.

Set a steel fence post approximately 5 feet East with Land Survey Monument sign attached.
