
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

## History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by Henry Meldrum under GLO contract number 450, dated June 11, 1882. Surveyor General record states:

Set basalt stone 18x10x4 ins 12 in in ground for closing corner to Secs 5 + 6 marked CC with 5 notches on E and 1 on W edges, from which;

A pine 40 in diam bears S16°W 54 lks dist marked R37E S6 BT A pine 4 in diam bears S32°E 44 lks dist marked T1S S5 BT A pine 7 in diam bears N7°W 31 lks dist marked T1N S32 BT



No record of subsequent monumentation found in Umatilla County survey records.

## Description of corner evidence found:

Found no evidence of the original corner monument.

Found a stump hole S32°E, 44 lks.

Found a 48 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine S16°W, 54 lks, live with a chop mark only visible evidence.

Found a rotted out Ponderosa Pine stump hole N7°W, 31 lks with piece of wood with scribe alongside.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At record bearing and distance from the above described found original bearing trees, I set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 26" inches in the ground, from which:

New Bearing Trees: A 12 inch diameter Douglas Fir bears S31°E, 36.3 feet marked T1S R37E S5 CC BT A 16 inch diameter Douglas Fir bears S17°W, 26.67 feet marked T1S R37E S6 CC BT

Painted a 6 inch red band around all BTs and attached bearing tree and land survey monument signs.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet East with land survey monument sign attached.

I hereby certify that the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on September 5, 1989.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of new accessories. I used 17° East magnetic declination and the distances are to a 50d spike driven in the right side of the root crown. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 644 to the BT blaze.
