Kimbrell's notes do not reveal anything set at the corner point. The position for this corner was computed by Steve Haddock in his Survey No. 13-555-C in 2013.

MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES FOUND: None. Reestablished corner point at proportional position reported on Survey No. 13-555-C.

MONUMENT SET: At the reestablished corner point, set a 1 1/4" by 30" galv. iron pipe with 2 3/8" brass cap 30" in the ground. Cap is marked as shown in "Monument Marking Detail".

A silver "Deep 1" magnet bears N 59° E, 27.8 feet. A pink "Deep 1" magnet bears S 39° E, 21.8 feet. A blue "Deep 1" magnet bears S 48°W, 22.5 feet. A orange "Deep 1" magnet bears N 17° W, 22.9 feet.

The Deep 1 magnets are buried 20" below ground line and have "bearing object" signs placed just above them. Set steel fence post 1 ½ feet South of corner with "witness" sign wired to it.
