CORNER DESIGNATION: G-1, The West one-quarter of corner of Section 7, Township 2 North, Range 28 East, W.M..

PREVIOUS RENEWALS/SURVEYS ETC: Corner originally established by David P. Thompson Contract No. 83 dated July 22, 1859. Notes state: Set post corner for 1/4 Sec. corner in mound of earth & as per instructions. This corner point was likely computed by Deputy Surveyor John Kimbrell in his Survey No. 357 in December, 1912. Dave Krumbein computed a position for this corner in his Survey No. L-42-A.

MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES FOUND: None. Corner was reestablished by single proportionate measurement between the reestablished Northwest corner of Section 7 and computed position for the Southwest corner of said Section 7. Posts of an ancient fence line extending North and South of the corner point was held for departure.

## MONUMENT MARKING DETAIL:

MONUMENT SET: A the reestablished corner position, set a 1 1/4" by 30" galv. iron pipe with 2 3/8" brass cap 29" in the ground. Placed a three stones beside the corner monument. Cap is marked as shown in Monument Marking Detail.

New accessories:

A silver "Deep 1" magnet bears N 49° E, 23.8 feet.

A blue "Deep 1" magnet bears S 57° W, 22.2 feet.

A orange "Deep 1" magnet bears N 42° W, 25.7 feet.

A 5/8" by 24" rebar with 1 1/4" red plastic cap bears North 129.2 feet. Set North of North edge of active wheat field.

The red plastic cap is marked "ORPLS 1106 WAPLS 17372". Rebar accessory has a "bearing object" sign wired to it. "Deep 1" magnets are set 20" in the ground with "bearing object" signs placed just above them.. Set steel fence post 1 ½ feet South of corner monument with "witness" sign wired to it.

LOCATION AND COMMENTS: Corner is located in an active wheat field about 120 feet South of a corner in the field.
