MONUMENT SET: Held the fence corner as best remaining evidence of the original corner location. Attempted to set a brass cap monument but hit a 4" buried irrigation pipe 12" below ground. At the corner point, set a 5/8 by 30" rebar with red plastic cap marked "OR PLS 1106 WA PLS 17372", just North of railroad tie fence corner post.

New accessories:

A 5/8" by 24" rebar with 1 1/4" red plastic cap bears S 881/2° E, 23.3 feet.

A 5/8" by 24" rebar with 1 1/4" red plastic cap bears S  $881/2^{\circ}$  E, 53.8 feet.

A 5/8" by 24" rebar with 1 1/4" red plastic cap bears South, 29.6 feet.

A 5/8" by 24" rebar with 1 1/4" red plastic cap bears South 48.9 feet.

The red plastic caps are marked "ORPLS 1106 WAPLS 17372". All rebar accessories are set in the existing fence lines and have "bearing object" signs wired to them. Nailed a "Witness" sign to a wood fence post just South of corner monument..
