At reestablished corner point, set a 2 3/8" brass cap on 1 1/4" x 30" galvanized iron pipe, 27" in the ground to bedrock. Monument marked as shown in monument marking detail. From which:

A silver Deep-1 magnet buried 22" below ground level bears North 38 1/2° East, 34.4 feet A blue Deep-1 magnet buried 22" below ground level bears South 25° East, 24.6 feet. A purple Deep-1 magnet buried 22" below ground level bears South 65 1/2° West, 36.6 feet. An orange Deep-1 magnet buried 22" below ground level bears North 26 1/2° West, 39.5 feet. Buried bearing object signs with all magnets. Set steel fence post with witness post sign 1 foot North of monument.
