## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

2N, R 32E. , W.M.

## History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established by D. Chaplin, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, under Contract No. 107, dated Hugust 21, 1864. The original hotes state that at the corner a 17 X 8 X 5 stone was set fro the corner from which:

A Balm 15 in diam. bears S 46 W 40 lks.

In January 1904, during County Survey No. 148, John Kimbrell, County Surveyor, recovered the original corner.

John Kimbrell also reports recovering the corner on at least one other private survey reported in books 1 and 2, Record of Private Surveys.

Several recent private surveys have shown the calculated position of this corner as being on line and half way between adjacent Section corners. There has been no recovery of this corner since the Kimbrell Surveys in the early 1900's.

## Description of corner evidence found:

None. Corner area has been disturbed by manmade and natural channel changes of the Umatilla River. Corner was re-established by single proportion measurement between recovered Section corners at the Northeast and Southeast corners of Section 7, using record from original Chaplin survey.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the re-established corner position, set a 2 1/2" brass cap on a 1 1/4" galvanized iron pipe, 24" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of stone. From the re-established corner point:

A 8" cottonwood bears S  $69^\circ$ W  $124.4^\prime$ , bark scribed 1/4 S7 BT. A 4" willow bears S  $37^\circ$ W  $46.5^\prime$  bark scribed 1/4 S7 BT. A 4" willow bears S  $20^\circ$ E  $53.1^\prime$  scribed 1/4 S8 BT. A 7" hawthorn bears N  $21^\circ$ E  $49.0^\circ$  bark scribed 1/4 S8 BT.

All bearing trees have bearing object signs nailed to them.

Set steel fence post 3' North of corner monument and attached witness corner sign.
