
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishmery

A 5/8" iron rod was set for the 1/4 corner and has been accepted for many years as being the 1/4 corner between sections 7 and 8 T2N R32E. The rod is shown on many of the surveys done in the area.



Description of corner evidence found:


A 5/8" Iron rod was found in a North-South fence line.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

The 5/8" Iron rod was referenced and removed. A Brass cap mounted on an iron pipe was then set in concrete for the new monument.

The brass cap is stamped "umatilla county surveyor 1/4 /8"

The cross in the center was set for true position from the references.
