Restoration of 2 cor. 17/16 T.2 N.R.32 EWM

History of original corner establishment:

- Post and mound set by Daniel Chaplin under contract No. 107, dated September 21, 1864
  - Post and mound set by Zenas F. Moody under contract No. 165, dated October 4, 1871.
  - Stone set by James P. Currin & James Noland under special contract dated May 4, 1887. Stone described as being 9x8x7 in. with "1/4" scribed on west face.

Survey by W.E.O. Criger, dated March 1951 shows "I.P. found"




A 1/2 "x32" iron pipe was found 4" below surface of ground and a stone 9x8x7 inches with 1/4 scribed on its side was found near the base of the pipe. The records called for "1/4" to be on west side of stone, but was found to be on the bottom.

Pictures of the iron pipe & stone are on file at City Engineer's Office.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

The iron pipe was referenced and the stone checked for "1/4" markings. The stone was replaced in its found position and reburied. A Umatilla County surveyors brass cap and pipe was placed over the 1/2" iron pipe and set in concrete: The Brass cap is stamped "1/4 COR 17/16" and punched for position from the reference hubs.
