## ZRTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

T 2N, R 32E., W.M.

History of original corner establishment:

Most recent approved GLO record, by Currin and Noland, under Special Contract dated May 4, 1887 States:

"Intersect E, & W, line 20 lks. East of old corner to Secs. 15, 16, 21 & 22, Set stone 8x9x10 ins. in old mound for cor. to sections 15, 16, 21 & 22 marked with 3 notches on E, & S. edges. Redug pits 18x18x12 ins. in each Sec. 5.1/2 ft. dist. and raised a mound or earth 2 ft. high 4 1/2 ft. base alongside:

The City of Pendleton called for a fence corner in a survey dated January, 1956. (City Record 24-7509).

0.5/8° x 30° iron oin monument was set at the fence corner in 1983, after the fence corner location was verified by survey. (Survey No. 83-73-8).

Description of corner evidence found:

A 5/8" by 30" iron pin on West edge of fence post at a East-West and South fence corner, set during Survey No. 83-73-8.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2 1/2" brass cap on a 1 1/4" by 30" galv. iron pipe over found iron pin. From the new monument:

A 5/8" by 30" iron pin bears N  $10^\circ$ W -  $26.50^\circ$  capped with a yellow plastic cap marked "W.R. Wells, PLS 1106". A 5/8" by 30" iron pin bears N  $87^\circ$ E -  $20.11^\circ$  capped with a yellow plastic cap marked "W.R. Wells, PLS 1106". A 5/8" by 30" iron pin bears S  $02^\circ$ E -  $20.00^\circ$  capped with a yellow plastic cap marked "W.R. Wells, PLS 1106". A 5/8" by 30" iron pin bears S  $87 1/2^\circ$ W -  $20.00^\circ$  capped with a yellow plastic cap marked "W.R. Wells, PLS 1106".

Set a 5.5' steel fence post, on rough line, approximately 1 foot from each pin, with a Bearing Object information sign attached.

Set a steel fence post 3' West of monument with a Witness Corner sign attached.
