

CERTIFICATE OF MONUMENTATION

March 12, 2003

I, Stephen K. Haddock, do hereby depose and say that I am a registered professional surveyor in the State of Oregon and that I referenced the existing monuments as described below which were to be destroyed by construction activities.

Lot 10, Block 156 of the Reservation Addition to the City of Pendleton, Umatilla County, Oregon, lying in the Northwest ¼ of the Northwest ¼ of Section 12, Township 2 North, Range 32 East, Willamette Meridian, was surveyed in August of 1967 by Mr. Stanley G. Wallulis. The survey is recorded as Umatilla County survey No. D-41-Ax.

The survey by Mr. Wallulis shows that the monuments he set along the south line of Lot 10 were set as reference monuments. The survey calls for 5/8" iron pins which were set 1.00 foot away from the lot corner points along the south line of the lot. I found 2 iron rebars, 5/8" x 24", along the south line of Lot 10 in the area to be disturbed by construction.


I referenced the monuments on Friday, August 23rd, 2002 prior to their destruction by construction. I do not know what date the monuments were actually destroyed. I replaced the monuments in their original locations on March 3, 2003 after the construction was completed. I set a 5/8" x 24" green coated iron rebar with a 1 1/8" orange plastic cap stamped WTS and 56295LS at the position of the southwest reference monument. I set a copper nail with a 5/16" x 1.5" shank and a 1 1/8" top stamped WTS and 56295LS in a drill hole in the north edge of the new sidewalk at the position of the southeast reference monument.


