History of original corner establishment:

The corner was originally established by Daniel Chaplin, under Contract No. 107, dated September 21, 1864. In which he set a post for the corner in a modund of earth with a tharred stake, pits, and etc, as per instructions.

The corner was re-established by Jas. P. Currin and Jas. Noland under Social Contract dated May 4, 1887. At that time, the "Old Corner" was found and a 8 x 10 x 12 inch stone was set to resonument the corner, marked with 5 notches on the East edge and 2 notches on the South edge. Raised mound of earth alongside and redug pits.

Note: The corner was re-established by 7.F. Moody, under Contract No. 165, dated October 4, 1871. Moody set a post and made an earth mound for the corner. This corner is the "Old Corner" referred to in the Currin and Noiand Record.

This corner was re-established as noted on Survey No. R-28-B, in 1980.

Description of corner evidence found:

A 2-1/2" brass cap on a 2-1/2" galv. iron pipe protruding 4-1/2" from ground, 6" West of a fence intersection. Monument set by Krumbein Engineering Co. as referenced in Map No. R-28-B.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Attached a Witness corner sign to the wooden post at the fence intersection 0.5 feet East.

New bearing objects: A 5/8" x 30" iron pin bears N 03° W - 43.3 feet. (Buried 12 inches in ground). A 5/8" x 30" iron pin bears N 87 1/2°E - 26.3 feet. (Driven flush with ground). A 5/8" x 30" iron pin bears S 41 1/2°E - 27.4 feet. (Buried 12 inches in grnd). A 5/8" x 30" iron pin bears S 07° W - 20.2 feet. (Buried 12 inches in ground).

All iron pins are capped with a 1 1/2" yellow plastic cap marked: "WR WELLS, PLS 1106". Bearing Object signs are wired to each pin.
