MONUMENT SET: After confirmation by survey, I accept the fence intersection as the best remaining evidence of the original corner location and set a 2 1/2" brass cap on a 1 1/4" x 30" galvanized iron pipe, 28" in the ground, with a mound of stone to the cap, (marked as shown in the monument detail). Set corner stone in mound West of monument.

Set steel fence post with witness sign 1.8 foot North of monument. A 5/8" x 30" iron pin with yellow plastic cap stamped "OR PLS 1106-WA PLS 17372" bears N 35  $1/2^{\circ}$  E-10.8 feet. A 5/8" x 30" iron pin with yellow plastic cap stamped "OR PLS 1106-WA PLS 17372" bears S 86 1/2° E-21.7 feet. A 5/8" x 30" iron pin with yellow plastic cap stamped "OR PLS 1106-WA PLS 17372" bears S 3° W-18.6 feet. A 5/8" x 30" iron pin with yellow plastic cap stamped "OR PLS 1106-WA PLS 17372" bears N 75° W-19.9 feet, top set 1 foot below ground. Set steel fence posts near iron pins with witness signs attached. Attached bearing object signs to each iron pin.
