Found a 1 1/4" iron rod at projection of North and East fences. The 1 1/4" iron rod was buried abouth 2'. See Survey No. 92-29-C.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2 1/2" brass cap on 1 1/4" by 30" iron pipe over the 1 1/4" iron rod and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone from which:

A brass washer in the SE corner of a shed bears N  $26\ 1/2^\circ W - 65.10^\circ$ . Washer is marked "PLS 1106". Attached Bearing Object sign to shed. A 5/8" by 30" rebar bears N  $03\ 1/2^\circ W - 25.00^\circ$  with a yellow plastic cap marked "W.R. Wells, PLS 1106" attached. A 5/8" by 30" rebar bears S  $88^\circ E - 20.00^\circ$  with a yellow plastic cap marked "W.R. Wells, PLS 1106" attached. A 5/8" by 30 " rebar bears S  $23\ 1/2^\circ E - 24.00^\circ$  with a yellow plastic cap marked "W.R. Wells, PLS 1106" attached.

Set a 5.5 foot steel fence post approximately 1 foot from each reference corner rebar with a Bearing Object information sign attached.
