## MONUMENT SET:

After thorough search, I determined the best remaining evidence of the corner location is the intersection of a three way road intersection with roads extending North, West and South. At reestablished corner position:

Set a 2 1/2" brass cap on a 1" x 30" galvanized iron pipe 6" below gravel road surface.

Accessories set:

A 5/8" x 30" iron rod with yellow plastic cap stamped "OR PLS 1106, WA PLS 17372" flush with ground bears, N 26° E, 45.3 feet.

A brass washer stamped "PLS 1106", 1.0 feet above ground in a UECA guy pole bears S 52° E, 31.2 feet.

A brass washer stamped "PLS 1106", 1.0 feet above ground in UECA power pole #169900 bears S 35° W, 22.8 feet. The Burke Road road sign pole bears N 13° W, 33.5 feet. All accessories have bearing object signs attached. 5/8" pin has steel fence post 1.0 feet beyond with witness sign attached.
